Fishing

Similar to many Haliburton area lakes, Miskwabi Lake is very deep in sections. In portions of the lake, the depth is over 43 m (140 ft) deep, making for fantastic summer holding areas for its resident lake trout population. There are also smallmouth and largemouth bass for anglers to look for.

Lake trout were first introduced into Miskwabi Lake in the mid 1960s. The Ministry of Natural Resources continues to stock the lake and fishing success has continued to escalate. Your best bet to find lake trout is to try during the winter through the ice or in spring just after ice off.

Jigging through the ice with a small spoon or lighter colour jig can be effective. Many people fish a single hole, but if it isn't producing, it isn't producing. A much more effective strategy is to drill a series of holes that can be fished in conjunction with a flash fish finder. Spend ten to fifteen minutes fishing a hole; if it turns up dry, move on to the next one, then the next one until you locate the elusive trout. Try and drill the holes across structure like drop-offs so that you can fish various depths.

During the spring, try trolling a spoon in the upper portion of the lake near drop-off areas and shoals. After summer approaches your best bet for success is to use a downrigger and troll deep for these trout, although jigging a large (1oz plus) jig right down at the bottom can also work very well. Lake trout often hit jigs on the way down, so pay attention.

Smallmouth and largemouth bass are the more dominant sportfish in this lake and provide for fair to good fishing at times for bass up to 1.5 kg (3.5 lbs). Smallmouth tend to favour the more rocky structure around the lake; therefore, try a jig or crayfish fly off points and other structured areas. Largemouth, on the other hand, like to find cover and are often located under docks or buried deep inside weedbeds. A weedless lure like a bass tube is a must when fishing down into the weeds.

When the sun is not directly on the lake in the morning and in the evening, largemouth will often come to the surface chasing bass poppers or floating lures. Smallmouth will sometimes rise, too, but not as frequently as largemouth.

Directions



East of Haliburton, Miskwabi Lake is accessible by following Highway 118 to Trappers Trail. This road heads north to the southwest end of Miskwabi Lake and the public access point. Another access is available to the east via the main road.

Facilities



There are two access points on Miskwabi Lake that visitors to the area can use. Those looking to stay in the area will find plenty to see and do around the cottage town of Haliburton.


Other Options



Long Lake lies to the west of Miskwabi Lake and can be reached from Miskwabi Lake by boat. Long Lake is best known for its bass fishing as decent populations of smallmouth and largemouth bass exist in the lake. Another nearby angling alternative is Hunters Lake. This smaller lake lies to the east and was once stocked with rainbow trout. There are also reports that bass exist in the lake.
